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REVISIONS IN JANUARY TO AUGUST 2000 CPI DATA

On September 28, 2000, the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) reissued Consumer Price Index (CPI) data for the January to August 2000 period. The revision corrected an error recently uncovered in the software used to calculate the Rent of Primary Residence and Owners' Equivalent Rent of Primary Residence components of the index. Correcting this error increases previously published values for those components and for index series shown below that include those components. Revisions affect both the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) and the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) at the U.S. city average level and for regional and metropolitan areas.

The following indexes are subject to revision. Not all of these categories are published for every region or local area.
